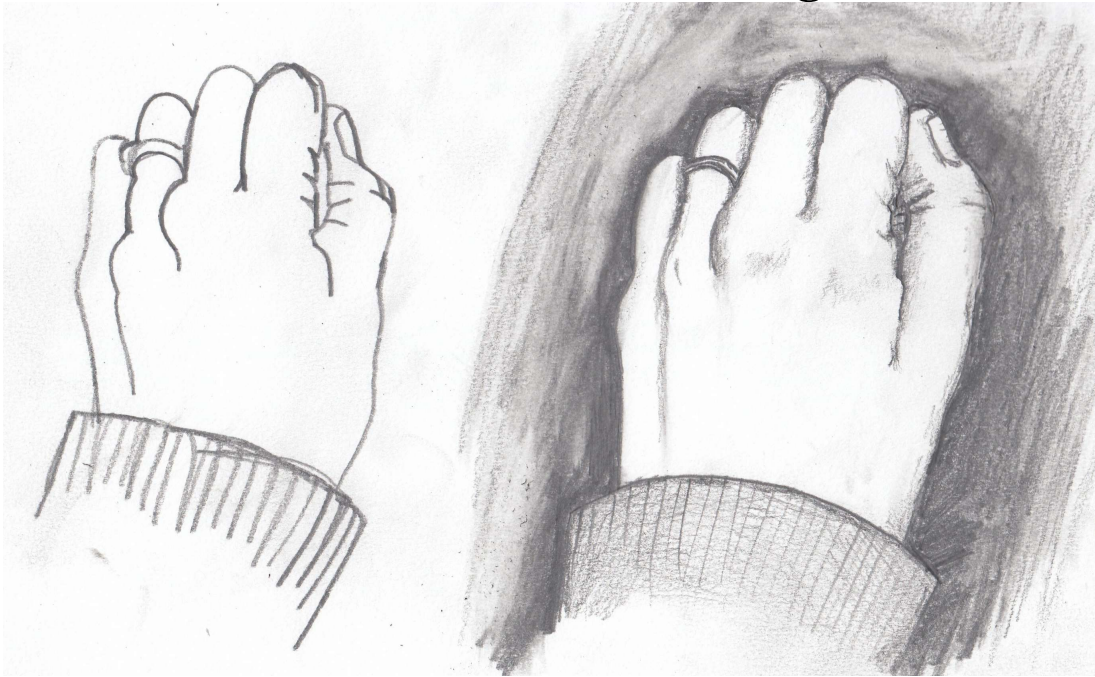


Art Activity #4

Continuous line drawings



Continuous line drawings force us to think carefully about what we are seeing because we have removed the option of correcting our work.

Activity: Students will draw an object, or their hand without lifting their pen or pencil from the page. If you have to lift the pencil begin where you left off. After at least one careful drawing the student may complete a full drawing based on the object they were studying.

Detailed steps to continuous line drawings:

Step 1: Choose an object, or your hand to observe.

Step 2: Pick where your line will begin. Place your pencil on the page. Do not lift it again!

Step 3: Follow the line of the object, you may cross back over your line. Go slowly and carefully considering before you move the pencil. No erasing or lifting the pencil.

Step 4: Good job! Now if you wish you may draw the same object as a normal linedrawing and complete it how you wish.
